5. Did you know that your student union, the University of Toronto Students' Union (UTSU, previously known as SAC) is negotiating with the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) for all its members to have access to the U-Pass? The U-Pass is a universal student transit pass that would permit its user to have unlimited access to all TTC services during the academic year. The U-Pass would cost students approximately \$60 per month, or \$480 for the academic year between September 1 and April 30. This would be \$36 LESS than the current optional UTSU VIP Metropass. BUT there would be no opt out for this new UTSU fee. All UTSU members, including all TST students, would have to pay the additional \$480 per year, irrespective of whether they use the TTC or not. Are you in favour of the U-Pass at the specified fee, with no possibility of opting out?
