

2016/17 Compulsory Non-Academic Incidental Fees (St. George student fees)

1. Applicable University of Toronto Governing Council Policies:

Policy for Compulsory Non-Academic Incidental Fees; and Council Memorandum of Agreement between The University of Toronto, The Students' Administrative Council, The Graduate Students' Union and The Association of Part-time Undergraduate Students for a Long-Term Protocol on the Increase or Introduction of Compulsory Non-tuition Related Fees (COSS Protocol)

Governance Process:

2. Outlined in the COSS Protocol; COSS reviews services and fees and provides advice to the University Affairs Board where fees are presented for approval

Membership on COSS consists of seventeen voting members:

- the President of the University or the person delegated by the President
- two part-time undergraduate students, appointed by APUS
- two graduate students, appointed by the GSU
- four full-time undergraduate students appointed by UTSU
- one full-time or part-time student, chosen by QSS
- one full-time or part time student, chosen by the CSS
- six other persons appointed by the President of the University of Toronto

COSS has a non-voting Chair appointed by University Affairs Board with nominee is selected from a list of candidates supplied by the student governments that are members of COSS

3. University Affairs Board receives advice from COSS and considers changes to fees.

2016/17:

Full time students are charged \$416.17 per session (semester) registered (Fall, Winter, Summer)

Part time students are charged \$83.25 per session (semester) registered (Fall, Winter, Summer)

The fees are calculated in the following way:
